Dear Parents,

Since last summer, I have been working with Mr. Clifton Hebert, Director of the Cameron Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, to be able to partner with his office when the "My State" alert notification system goes online for all Cameron Parish residents. The partnership will allow our school families to receive all of the Cameron Parish notifications, but also allow for notifications to be sent only for school business. The school notifications may apply to all schools and would be sent in any and all ways that you request (home phone, voice message, cell phone, voice message, text message, e-mail, fax). In other cases, the notification may involve only one school and all parents, faculty and staff of that school will be notified. There is no cost to the parents, faculty or staff of our schools for this service.

If you choose to participate and you did not return the appropriate form to school, you must fax it to the Cameron Parish School Board office at 905-5572.

Please be advised that the Cameron Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness will be testing the system this summer. If there is a need, I will utilize the system this summer, once it has been tested.

I do hope that you agree that an alert notification system is one of the quickest ways that we can get information to all parents or caregivers, in case of an emergency. It will also be helpful for important information that is not of an emergency nature. By partnering with the Cameron Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, you will only need to be registered with one system, rather than both a school and a parish alert system. I hope that you find this system helpful.
